Winter Holiday Fun



I. Welcome

Be sure to have your materials ready before the video session starts and always ask an adult for help and permission.

II. Activity Overview

- Campers will engage in some winter holiday fun! They will make small holiday trees and fun turkey headbands they can rock at their turkey celebrations/feasts!

V. Activity

- Paper cup holiday tree



- Get your gold glitter paper and cut a star out – you can trace the star and then cut out; glue near the top of the cup (opening face down)
- Glue pom poms and sequins on the green paper cup (if you have other fun things at home you want to add to your tree, do it!) – on one side write you name and camp name! This will be our camp badge displays!
- Use the thumbtack – with a parent or trusted adults help and permission to punch a hole on the top of the cup



- Grab your holiday string and push both ends into the hole
- Tie your jingle bell inside of your cup so your holiday tree jingles!
- You can hang on a holiday tree or simple use for a fun party decoration! Remember to display this at every activity so we can see your name and camp name!

• **Turkey headband**



- Take your brown construction paper and cut into 2-inch strips – you will need to measure your head with the paper and then tape the construction paper together to form a headband
- Take your red construction paper and trace out feathers (can do 2 or 3 big ones) and then tape to the back of your headband on the inside
- Get your orange construction paper and cut into the shape of a triangle (not too small! This will be your turkey's beak) use about half of the construction paper for the beak and tape on to the front of the headband – across from the feathers; make sure it is placed in the middle, keep room for the eyes
- Take your white paper and cut out a circle (these are the eyeballs for the turkey) – tip would be to cut out 1 circle then trace it on the other white paper and cut out the circle
- Get the 2 black dots and stick one on each white piece – those will be the eye/pupil – tape onto the front of the headband just above the beak
- You did it! Now let's talk about our favorite dish at our turkey feasts!

VI. Clean Up
