Shamrock Magic



I. Welcome

Be sure to have your materials ready before the video session starts and always ask an adult for help and permission.

II. Activity Overview

- **Campers will engage in a fun rainbow experiment using skittles! They will also create Mosaic Paper Shamrocks!**

V. Activity

- **Rainbow Experiment**
 - **Take your small plate and on the outer edges line the skittles into a circle**
 - **Add medium temperature water to the middle – you want to add enough water to where the water reaches the skittles on the edge**
 - **Wait about 30 seconds to see the colors begin to come out, you'll see the color come out**
 - **You can mix the colors together and see what color it turns!**



• Mosaic Paper Shamrocks

- Cut a shamrock shape out of plain green paper (below there is a shamrock outline you can use to help with the shamrock shape)
- Get your patterned colored green paper and cut into strips and then into squares
- Apply glue to the shamrock cut out and start placing paper mosaic squares onto the shape – it is ok if the squares overlap the edges of your shamrock, they can be trimmed down later
- Once your shamrock is full trim down the edges of any overlapping squares and there you have your Mosaic Paper Shamrocks!
